

## MFS 2010 Project Graduation Parental Permission Form and Participant Contract

2010 Graduates – Welcome to YOUR Project Graduation! Carefully read, sign, and date the following document and return to Susan Shaffer, 714 Cornwallis Drive, Mt. Laurel, NJ 08054 by Friday, May 21. It is the first step on your journey to the ULTIMATE GRADUATION CELEBRATION.

1. Participating 2010 graduates will be transported by bus to the Project Graduation event. The bus will depart from the Dining Hall Commons on June 12<sup>th</sup> at 9:15PM. The bus will return to MFS at 6:30AM on June 13<sup>th</sup>. Parents, please make arrangements to pick up your graduate promptly at 6:30AM on Sunday morning. Students will **not** be allowed to leave their cars on campus overnight. This is for the safety of our children as they will undoubtedly be exhausted from Saturday's events.
2. At no time during the event will participants be permitted to leave the group or the Project Graduation venue(s). This is for the safety and security of our graduates and their chaperones.
3. Participants are expected to adhere to all MFS policies as outlined in the Parent Student Handbook during Project Graduation. Failure to do so will result in separation from the group and a phone call to parents for immediate pick up from the event.
4. Project Graduation is open to CLASS of 2010 MFS graduates only. No guests are permitted.
5. For the security of items brought along, individual, personalized Zip-Loc bags will be provided by the chaperones. ALL personal items, **including cell phones and other mobile devices**, will be collected by the chaperones and held in a secure location during the entire event. Items will be returned at the end of the event.
6. Prescription and over-the counter medications must be packaged in original, labeled containers, placed in a labeled bag and surrendered to the chaperones as students board the busses at the beginning of the event. All medications **MUST** be listed on the enclosed Medication Information & Authorization to Treat Form. Students will be permitted to self carry EPI-pens or inhalers. **Parents, please be sure your child has the necessary medical supplies to last the duration of the event.**
7. To maintain the SPIRIT, INTEGRITY and COMMUNITY of the event, portable electronic devices will not be allowed. Students will be highly engaged during the entire evening with little down-time for portable entertainment. Thank you in advance for your strict adherence to this rule!
